

## Raga: Hamsadhwani

Hamsa = swan
Dhwani = Sound
Means Sound of a swan.

Raga Arohana : S R2 G2 P N2 S

Avarohana: S N2 P G2 R2 S

S - Shadjam

R2- Chatusruti rishabham

G2- Antara gandharam

P - Panchamam

N2- Kaakali nishadam


The raga evokes bhakti rasa. It is derived from the parent scale (melakarta) called dheera sankarabharanam.

### Hamswadhwani

 Paramahamsa is the title of honor applied to enlightened. Divine vehicle for goddess saraswati. Aham + Sa (self and brahman)

"Paramahamsa" Sadasiva brahmendra mudra

- Hamsadhwani is an excellent choice to begin any concert. It is a perfect opener.
- Hamsadhwani is known by the same name in both Hindustani and Carnatic music traditions.
- Muthuswamy Deekshitar is known for bringing forth the introduction of this raga.
- Hamsadhwani is classified as an Upanga raga because it does not contain any
