

The raga sankarabharanam is derived from dheera sankarabharanam melakartha



Prasiddha raga, sampurna raga.

The raga evokes tranquility, devotion - shanti, Bhakti rasa it creates pleasant atmosphere, makes listener sleep (a serene ambiance that lulls the listener into a peaceful slumber.)

Sankarabharanam Narasayya, an eminent vocalist, was honored with the title "Sankarabharanam" preceding his name.

The swara sthanas very similar to Kalyani raga except Madhyamam (Ma note) - Kalyani has Prati madhyamam, sankarabharanam has suddha madhyamam.

It is crucial for the singer to refrain from rendering the "Ni" note in its plain form, as it closely resembles another raga known as Kalyani when sung as such.

Graham swara: Sa Ga Pa

Nyasa swara: Sa, Pa, Ma, Ga, Ni




